Nursing Reassessment
CSH-135**

The Nursing Reassessment is a replacement of the Psychiatric Nursing Assessment Update (form CSH-184A), the 15 page Nursing Assessment and Data Base, and the Unified Reassessment. It is a document designed to gather additional data that is not available on admission when there is a significant change in the client's condition. It is also done during transfer, and annually. This will be done using the following guidelines:

1. The Nursing Reassessment should be done:
 - a. When there is a significant change in the client's condition.
 - b. Within 24 hours after transfer to another unit by the RN on the receiving unit.
 - c. Annually by the assigned RN.
2. Since this is a reassessment, it is important to identify any changes in the client's condition on the data that was obtained on admission. In addition, it is also important to note the client's lack of response to previous interventions by the treatment staff.
3. A Reassessment Summary must be completed after completion of the reassessment, and must be reflected in the ISP.
4. Any significant findings and the interventions utilized should be documented in the progress notes.
