SUBJECT: **Entertainment DVDs and Video Cassettes (NEW)**

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines for the selection of entertainment DVDs and/or videocassettes.

POLICY

Central State Hospital (CSH) will adhere to the Federal Copyright Act, Public Law 94-553, title 17 of the United State Code. An entertainment DVD or video by law, as well as by intent, is the pre-recorded DVDs/videocassettes which are available in stores throughout the United States for home use only. Rentals or purchases of home DVDs/videocassettes do not carry with them license for non-home showing. Before they can be legally shown outside the home, organization, company there must be a separate license, which specifically authorized the showing of DVDs/videocassettes.

DVDs and Videocassettes purchased by Central State Hospital and/or given to CSH may not be edited, or otherwise modified. Videocassettes/DVDs taped off of television may not be shown at Central State Hospital. It is a violation of the United States Federal Copyright Code for staff members to bring a DVD/videocassette from home and show it at the hospital.

Central State Hospital is licensed to show home DVDs/videocassettes under the Motion Picture Licensing Corporation umbrella license. However, Central State Hospital may purchase or receive as a gift only DVDs/videocassettes from those motion picture studios and independent specialized program distributors represented by the Motion Picture Licensing Corporation.

The following are criteria for DVD/videocassette selection:

- a. Be age related;
 - b. Be socially responsible;
 - c. Activate people in a positive manner; and
 - d. Contain no excessive violence or sexual content.

Activity Therapy
Coordinator/Designee

The Activity Therapy Coordinator or their designee will purchase and/or rent all entertainment DVD's and/or videocassettes.

Quarterly the Activity Therapy Coordinator or their designee will develop a list of the movies to be purchased, the producer and distributor, the cost, and the vendor to be utilized.

The Activity Therapy Coordinator or their designee will request, from Patient's Benefit Fund (PBF), funds to purchase DVD's and/or videocassettes.

Activity Therapy

All entertainment DVD's and/or videocassettes will be housed in the Central State Hospital (CSH) Auditorium.

All Staff

Entertainment DVD's and/or video cassettes may be checked out by staff for three (3) days through the Activity Therapy Service Auditorium staff.

Auditorium Activity
Leader/Designee

The Activity Therapy Coordinator must approve all movie purchases. Only staff designated by the Activity Therapy Coordinator will be allowed to purchase or rent DVD's or videocassettes. Rentals will be limited to the monthly hospital wide movie shown in the Auditorium.

Activity Therapy

Quarterly the Activity Therapy Coordinator will request suggestions for movies to be purchased from individuals and staff.

Prior to an individual bringing a movie from home, to be shown at CSH, they must have the approval of the Activity Therapy Coordinator.

Donors

An individual or group wishing to donate DVD's and or videocassettes to CSH, must present the donations to the office of the Activity Therapy Coordinator for review and acceptance or rejection.
